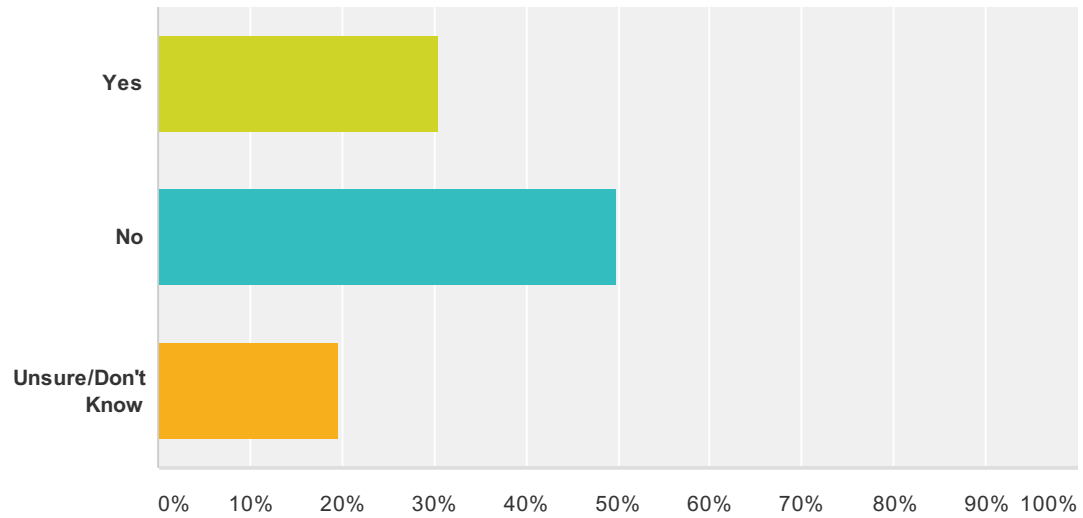

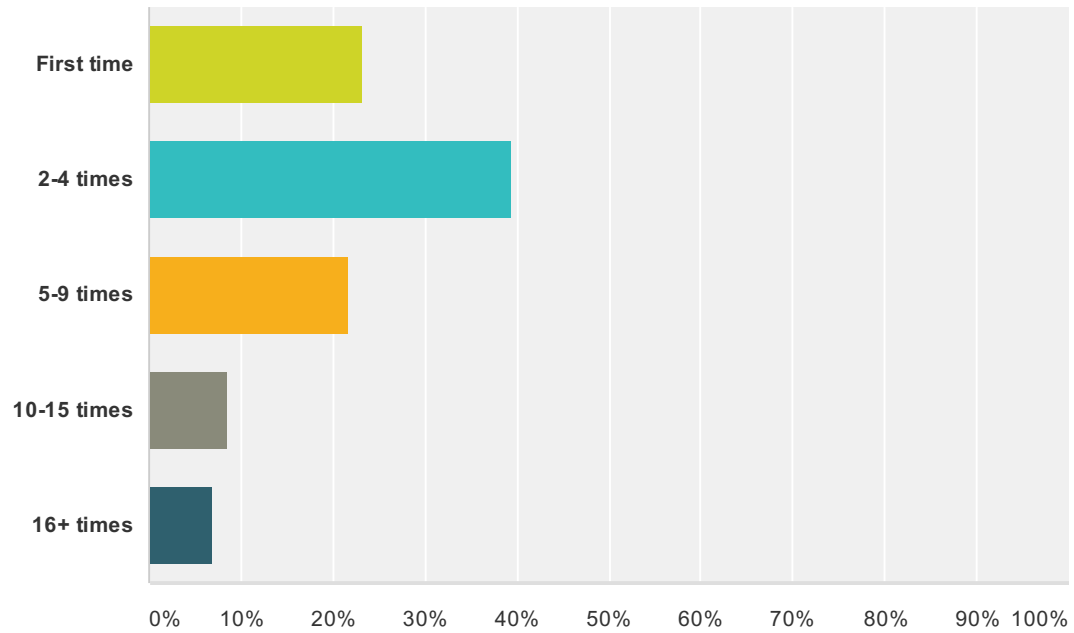

Q4 Number of times you have attended the WACA Conference?

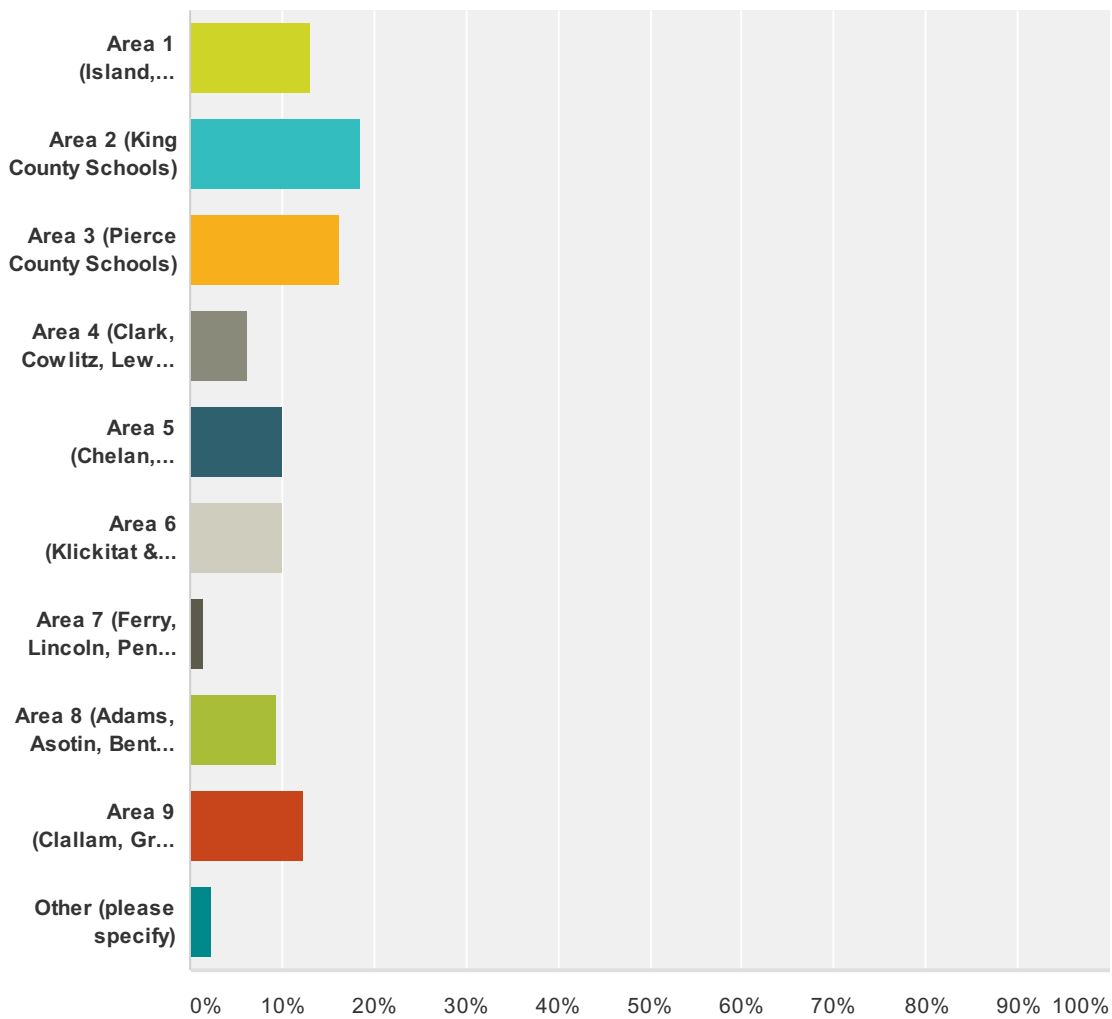

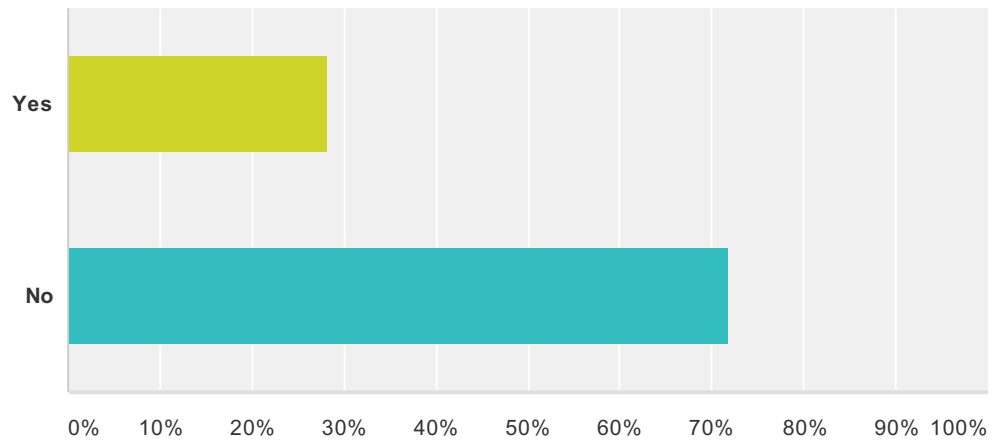

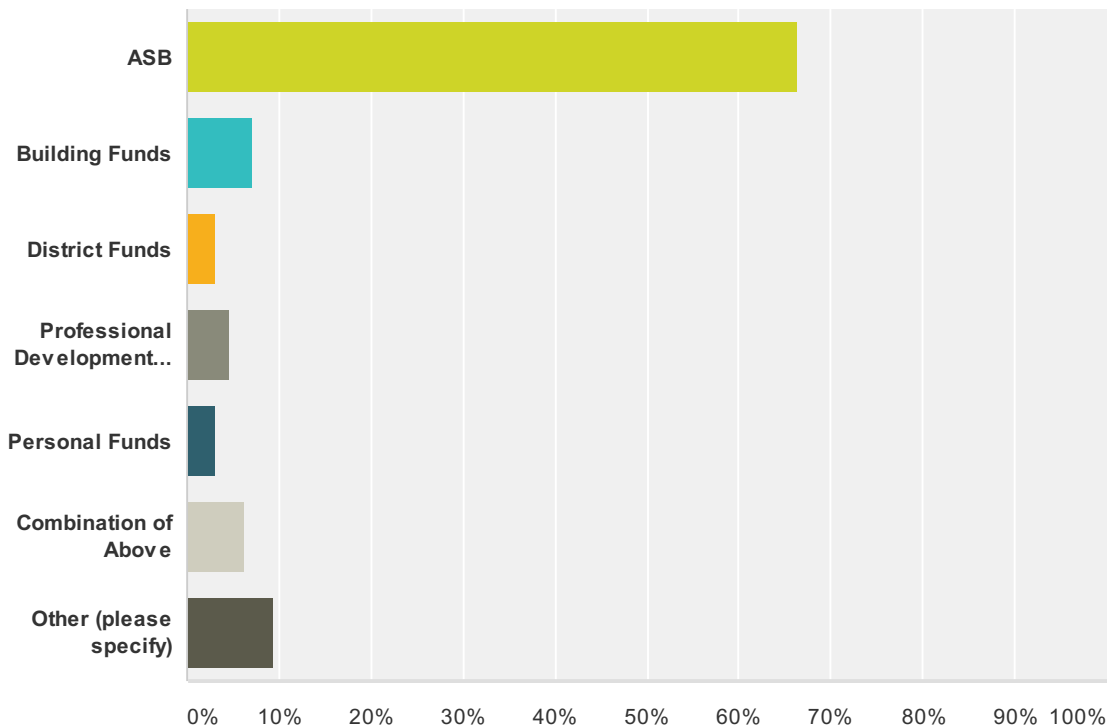

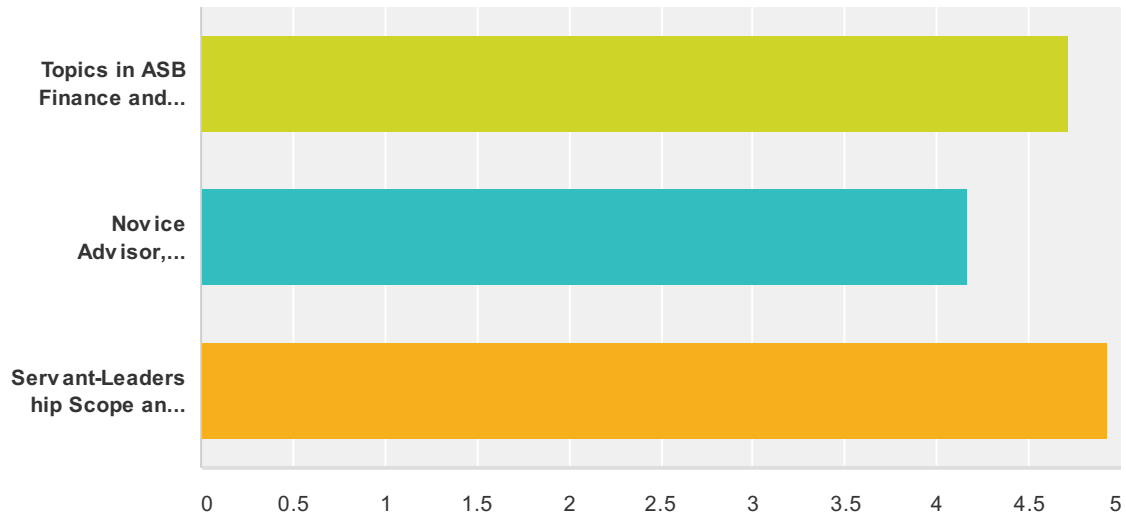

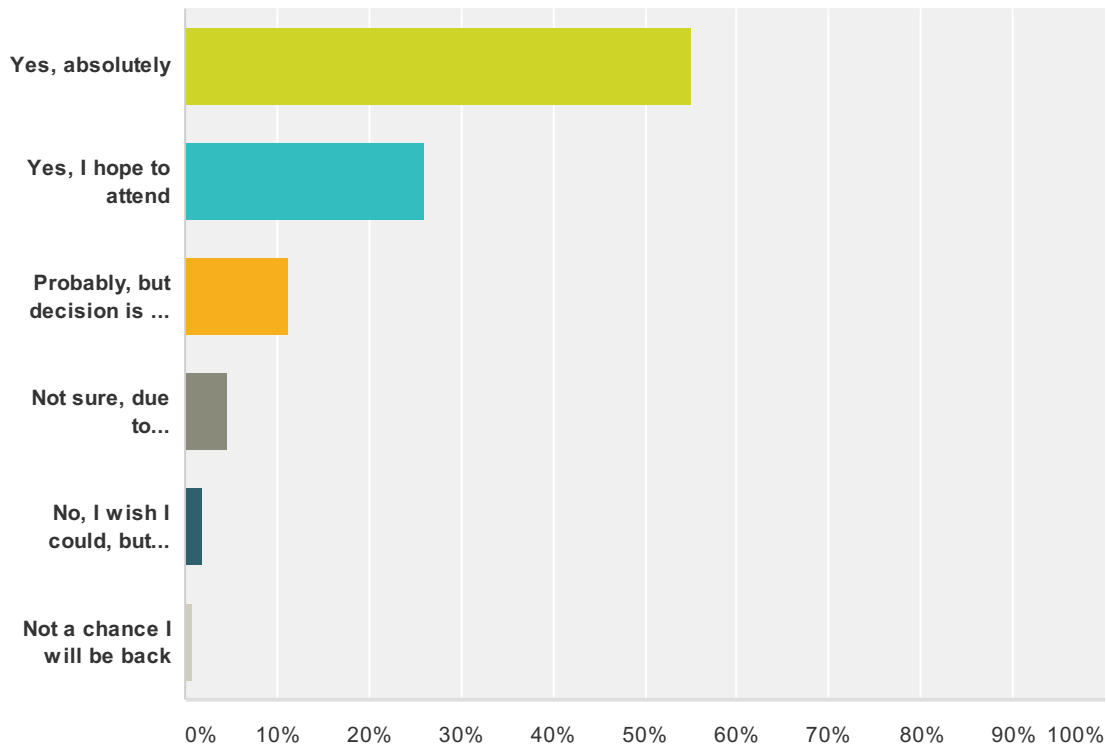
