Aubrey Terrill– Spanaway MS. Building our heritage club. Had momentum last year but haven't started yet this year. Jennifer's idea – get together to create, food, share, iMovie, cooking club

Club Fairs –

Shorecrest had clubs prepare a 30-60 second video and used Zoom Rooms to learn about clubs

Kentridge used Flipgrid to prepare a 30-60 second video and put links on Teams

Tahoma used google slides and put the info on the school website

Shorewood did club videos and put them on the school website

Club Organization –

Shorecrest uses google drive with a folder for each club – there is also templates for the clubs from ASB in each of their folders. When advisers change hands, and the officers change the information is still in the folder.

Other Events/Activities –

Games Night at Prosser – they set up a channel for game. They played Kahoots, Among Us, Jackbox It was 3 hours – students could come and go.

Scavenger Hunt at Shorecrest – they hid items around town and students went to find them

Kent SD – Lindsey Duerre said they have been told to be completely hands off

Make sure to check liability with your district for whatever event you plan

Arlington HS – Julie Martin – her students have been volunteering at the Clothing Closet and the Food Bank – 6 students can volunteer at a time at each of these venues. The students enjoy it because they are giving back to the community and have safe connection with their peers.

Off Campus Birthday Celebration for a teacher on campus – students stood just on the other side of the fence and celebrated the staff member.

Recognition – drop off gift bags at teacher houses – or maybe a student house

Virtual Fundraisers – depend on your district policies.

Point of sales at your schools allow for online sales of spirit gear etc.

Spirit packs to new students to advertise the spirit gear.
